Qualification of Students

Any student (male/female) who meet the qualifications listed below can apply for exchange student program at University

- 1) Nominated by their home university
- 2) Undergraduate students must have completed at least one semester at their home university
- 3) Language Requirement: Language Proficiency in either Korean or English Language
(Submission of Official scores is not mandatory)



College/School with course restrictions or limitation

No limitation.
However, some courses may not be available if certain prerequisites are required and/or the course has specialized limitations
